Reflections From Raindrops...

I remember many years ago in a workshop Patrick put forth a riddle. It has since turned into a question for me, one that arises and disappears, arises and disappears like the waves of the ocean. How do you imagine something that has never been before?

Those of you who are working with or have worked with Why Not! can recall the exercise dealing with Akasha. Well, when confronted with this exercise, a flood of insight surfaced. The concept of "NEW", we say, "new this or new that". Yet, when I contemplated *"that everything that ever was, is or could be exists right here and right now"*, how then could there be anything new, (except maybe in our own personal experience)?

So, let me get back to the flooding. What was the gift of the floods besides 100% full dams and an end to the drought – what was the subtle and delicate message and seeing that I received? I arrived home one day after the sun had come out and noticed three different types of frogs, two of which I had not seen in about 20 years. I also realized, that besides initially, when the rain started I had not seen a single cane toad. Cane toads were introduced to deal with another pest and became an unaccounted for pest. I have actually learned to like them.

In speaking with people about the rain, people who had lived here for a long time (over 20 years) said, this weather was like the wet season used to be over 20 years before. I understood why I found it unnatural, because I had never experienced a healthy wet season and the disappearance of the toads I felt maybe was connected to my intent to connect with the atoms of the earth and inspire its greatness. Maybe the rain, had triggered the seeds of memory within the earth into coming alive and sprouting??? BOOK REVIEW...

*I have just finished reading a book called **Your Body's Many Cries For Water: A revolutionary natural way to prevent illness and restore good health** written by Dr. F. Batmanghelidj.*

About the author...

Dr. Batman, as he is affectionately called, was born in Teheran, Iran. He trained as a doctor at St. Mary's Hospital Medical School of London University, and then returned to Iran to set up medical centres and clinics. But when the Shah was overthrown the intelligentsia was persecuted. He, too ended up being imprisoned and was convicted to death. However in prison he proved to become such an asset to the prison authorities that his death sentence was delayed. It was during this time that he discovered the magical powers of water - his only means of 'medication' available. After two years and seven months of imprisonment he was released and eventually managed to flee the country. Since then and until his death in 2004 he researched water and its effects upon the human body. He has written several other books on water and its effects. His books are published by <http://www.tagman-press.com/>

In his book he discusses the idea that we do not drink enough water and over time we train our body to ignore the feeling/cries of thirst from our body. We drink then only when the side effects of dehydration become noticeable. We suffer, he claims, from chronic dehydration.

He suggests that if we were to make sure our body was well hydrated we would avoid many diseases that plague humanity. In his view, prescribed medicines (chemical compounds) deal only with symptoms and they have side effects, some quite severe.

Water, on the other hand, is easy and safe to take. It all makes sense! We consist of mostly water; babies up to 92% water, the elderly around 75%. In his opinion we maintain a balance between water and matter in our bodies by drinking between two and three litres every day – pure, straight cold water.

Nexus Magazine, Australia, in their research said of Dr. Batmanghelidj...

He has successfully treated allergies, angina, asthma, arthritis, headaches, hypertension, ulcers and more with the simplest of solutions - water.

In my view then, it should not come as a surprise that the medical authorities and pharmaceuticals have not taken kindly to his research and results.
