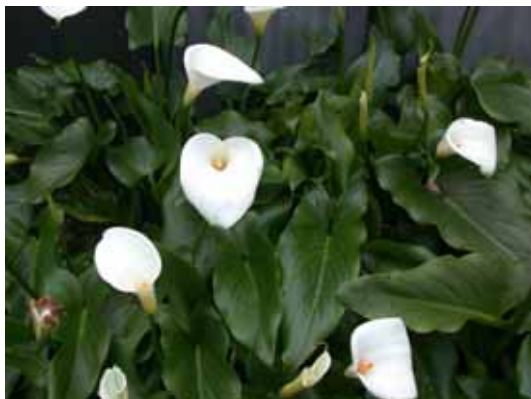

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Journey to Self...

How interesting to know or at least to contemplate life being a journey to Self, one might say. And so the attempt here is to present a view from inside out and perhaps at times, upside down! Consider for the sake of really letting go, just because it is easier said than done, how much of a sticking point it can be to merely know the words without becoming the person who has no emotional or mental investment in a person, event or thing any more.

Sometimes we need a little help to dump it. We watched some excerpts from the movie, *Good Will Hunting* on the last night of Module 4. There is one scene where Will received the help he needed without knowing he needed any help at all. It is the scene where the psychologist repeats the words to Will; *It's not your fault*. Will knew, i.e. had the knowledge, that it wasn't his fault, but as Patrick pointed out, he never had become innocent.

“What have I become” then, is possibly the most propelling question to ask of oneself.

Can we regard this kind of spontaneity as an altruistic act now? Having unselfish regard has no strings, no expectations of reward or acknowledgement. Have we let go enough to embrace its true meaning? Or is it still a dirty word?

It is not easy to let go of attachment to familiarity when it no longer serves us, but we are strongly reminded that it is essential that we do. What lies on the other side of time is now in our hands.

They were too **close** to the door to **close** it.

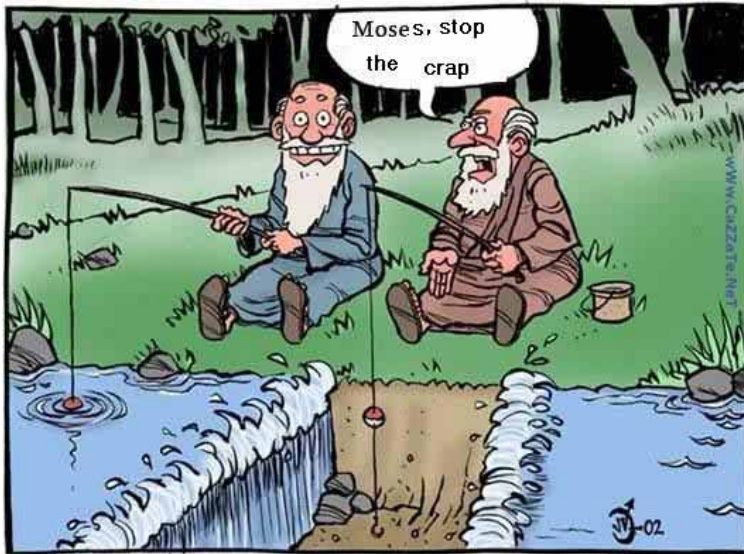
Upon seeing the **tear** in the painting I shed a **tear**.

Interesting research...

Article reproduced here was an article in Adelaide’s Advertiser this day, Saturday, March 13, 2010...

MRI scan can read minds, say scientists

LONDON: A scan of brain activity can effectively read a person’s mind, researchers say.

University College London scientists found they could differentiate brain activity linked to different memories and thereby identify thought patterns by using functional magnetic resonance imaging.

The evidence suggests researchers can tell which memory of a past event a person is recalling from the pattern of their brain activity alone.

“We’ve been able to look at brain activity for a specific episodic memory – to look at actual memory traces,” said the senior author Eleanor Maguire in the online *Current Biology*.

“We found our memories are definitely represented in the hippocampus. Now we’ve seen where they are, we have an opportunity to understand how memories are stored and how they may change through time.”

The results follow the same team’s finding they could tell where a person was standing in a virtual reality room in the same way. The new results show episodic memories – recollection of everyday events – are expected to be more complex, and thus more difficult to crack, than spatial memory. **AFP**

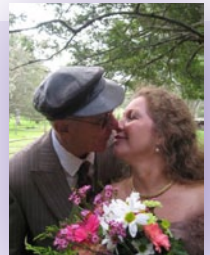

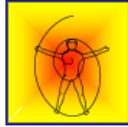
